3) Dark Access Channels:

JR informed the group that the Council has voted to send letters to the appropriate officer (Mayor, 1st Selectman, or Superintendent) responsible for each I-Net transmission location that is still dark. The letter will request a firm response as to the town's intention for utilizing the transmission site, and remind the official of the possible loss of transmission equipment at under-utilized locations. The contact information for the appropriate local educational or government representative will be included.

4) Access Awards Program:

The group reviewed 61 entries to the Access Awards Program. Each member gave a score (based on the rubric on the back of the entry form). Members are to fill in the scoring spreadsheet and return the scores via e-mail to J. Repicky. Due to the high number of entries, we were not able to complete the awards process.
